

## **LaTonya Rogers Six-Month Action Plan for District Six**

### **January 2019**

- Meet with other school board members to discuss my ideas
- Begin a six-month listening session tour of all schools in District Six
- Develop a Parent University presentation to be delivered at targeted Achievement Zone Schools
- Begin monthly brainstorming sessions with principals in District Six to develop best practices models and to solicit proposals to identify the needs of the schools
- Create an HOA community/PTO/PTA partnership in areas where there is a need

### **February 2019**

- Organize Student Governance Councils and conduct budget presentations
- Coordinate Title One Presentations with schools in District Six
- Meet with technical and two-year schools to develop partnerships through internships and job shadowing programs
- Continue to meet with principals in District Six to conduct brainstorming sessions

### **March 2019**

- Coordinate National Association for Admission Counseling/College Signing Day Event
- Lead three-month review of brainstorming meetings with principals in District Six to determine what can and will be accomplished in the next three-months
- Meet with Dr. Eric Thomas, Chief Turnaround Officer of the Georgia Department of Education to discuss three-month anecdotal information obtained from principals and community stakeholders
- Continue to meet with HOA communities in a coordinated effort to develop PTO/PTA collaborative efforts where there is a need

### **April 2019**

- Establish a Spring Break Academy for Achievement Zone Schools
- Reconvene with Principals in District 6 to continue brainstorming sessions to develop new best practices and to identify additional needs not discussed at previous meetings

### **May 2019**

- Conduct Glows and Grows community outreach meetings
- Meet with Principals to develop a list of proposals from principals/best practices

### **June 2019**

- Continue to conduct Glows and Grows community outreach meetings
- Meet with Principals in District Six Brainstorming Session (Proposals from principals/best practices)

### **July 2019**

- Review current six-month plan and develop a new six-month plan based on items that were completed and were successful along with the projects that were not completed or were not successful
